



Bible Story Mary's Journey to Bethlehem

Luke 2:1-20

Castle Callout

Armor Up with Peace!

Materials

- dark blue card stock
- silver sequins (can be multiple sizes or all one size)
- cotton swabs
- white crayon or chalk
- school glue
- canning jar lids (about 3 1/2" in size works best)
- ribbon
- tape
- markers
- scissors
- Craft Theme Stickers**

Bible Tie-In

This Christmas ornament will help us to remember the birth of Jesus and that he is the Prince of Peace.

Make-It-And-Take-It Craft Snowflake Ornament

Purpose

Knights will create a Christmas ornament to help them remember the Castle Callout.

Ages

Appropriate for all ages. Younger children will need help.

Preparation

Gather supplies. Trace the circle insert for the jar lid.

Directions



Step 1: Using chalk or white crayon, draw a large, wide X in the middle of the circle insert cut from dark blue card stock.

Step 2: Draw a line through the middle of the X.

Step 3: Using a cotton swab, put a dot of glue in the middle of the snowflake and add a sequin.

Step 4: Glue sequins on the spokes of the snowflake.

Step 5: Continue gluing sequins along the spokes of the snowflake.



Step 6: Fill all spokes with sequins.

Step 7: Randomly add tiny sequins around the circle for extra sparkle.

Step 8: Insert the circle insert into the canning lid.

Make a loop with ribbon and tape the bottom of the loop inside the label.

Craft Tip!

Both sides of the ornament can be used. On the side opposite the snowflake, add the "Armor Up with Peace" sticker to the back of the craft.

Make-It-And-Take-It Bible Craft Shoes of Peace

Purpose

Knights will create part of the Armor of God to help them to remember their quests from VBS.

Ages

Appropriate for all ages.

Preparation

Write the word PEACE on both socks with a black fabric marker.

Tape the socks to the table. This will make it easier to color the socks.

Directions



Step 1: Insert a divider in the sock to prevent color bleeding on the other side.



Step 2: Decorate the socks with red and green fabric markers. (These colors were selected as a tie-in to the Christmas story. However, you may use any colors you choose.)

- other colors of fabric markers (optional)

That night baby Jesus was born. Jesus is also called the Prince of Peace. Our socks will help us remember to be more like Jesus in all we do and say.
